Maggie Biggs reported that there is currently a balance of \$11,367 in our checking. So far this calendar year our expenses are higher than our income with a net deficit of \$2,105. The latest reconciled bank statement was available for viewing.

Dave updated us and indicated he should have a certified list of referees by end of December or early January.

Bonnie Larson informed us that the Girl's High School season is spread out over a longer time period this spring. It will start concurrently with the Boy's H.S. season. Rod Dougherty suggested that a survey of referees be performed to ascertain number and availability of H.S referees.

Bonnie inquired if there were any assignor's courses scheduled. Phil Sinnwell said this would be looked into.
