For 2005 we will get the same fees that we received last year for working the games. \$45.00 and \$40.00. Freshman games will be \$40.00 for a 2 man system. MISOA will get a \$5.00 increase in assigning fees per team per school. The CIML will also pay a single vehicle mileage if you have to travel outside of the golden circle or 30 miles one way to a game.

For 2006 we will get a \$2.50 increase in the fee for the Varsity match only and MISOA will get a \$5.00 increase in assigning fees per team per school.

For 2007 we will get a \$2.50 increase in the fee for the Junior Varsity games only. MISOA will not get any raise in assigning fees this year.

The Non CIML schools will be send a letter agreeing to the same game fees for 2005 as 2004 with a \$5.00 increase in assigning fees per team per school. Non-CIML have also made a proposal of 1.5 games.

The Ref Academy is still registering referees for the clinic on March 5th. If you would like to go to this and need a ride, there may be a bus for Saturday only if enough referees are interested. Contact Hidajet Tica in order to register and get on the bus list.
