Committee Reports

Director's Reports

- **College:** Jim is beginning to work on the college schedule. Greg Annexstad reports that the eastern side of the state did not express significant concern at the IRC meeting regarding the Iowa Conference. He suggests individuals may wish to express their concern in the form of a written complaint to the supervisor of the Iowa Conference.
- **Scholastic.** Rod Dougherty reported on game fees for 2007 in the CIML Freshman games \$42.50 for all JV \$47.50 games and all Varsity contests remain \$47.50. He recommends that referees check to assure that they were paid \$87.50 and not \$85.00 as he did in one assignment. He suggests that we raise the assigning fees for the CIML. A motion to pay Jim Hart the remainder of the 2006 spring season assignor's fee at the contracted \$6.00/ game for 1164 games = \$6984 – \$2500 advanced earlier = \$4484 was made, seconded and past.
